Youthdale is seeking a Full-Time (Permanent) Psychotherapist or a Social Worker to join its Centre for Individual and Family Therapy (C.I.F.T.) team. This is a perfect opportunity for someone who is wanting to gain more clinical experience working with clients and their families.

The ideal candidate must be able to successfully manage their own caseload including clinical documentation, demonstrate flexibility, and be self-motivated. This individual will also possess excellent organization, communication and interpersonal skills and the ability to work effectively within a dynamic, multidisciplinary team environment.

Areas of Responsibilities

- Conducting regular family therapy sessions with outpatient, day treatment and residential treatment clients.
- Attending school meetings in the classroom, psychology meetings and Plan of Care meetings at our residences.
- Attending team consultations and trainings.
- Meeting with Residential Supervisors to coordinate each client's individual treatment plan and consulting on family work and family contact, admission and discharge planning.
- Writing required assessments, session notes and reports.
- Producing the Plan of Care reports for each client.
- Liaising with clients and their caregivers as well as other professionals such as school personnel, probation workers, Children's Aid workers
- Provide case management, transition/discharge support and outreach services to ensure coordination and delivery of services to meet the needs of clients.
- Attend weekly supervisions with clinical supervisor for case specific discussion.
- Working 2-3 evenings per week.

Candidates will need to have a valid driver's license. The successful candidate will have to provide verification of a clean driving record.

Qualifications

- A Masters of Social Work (MSW) or equivalent education is required.
- Membership in good standing with the Ontario College of Social Workers or the College of Registered Psychotherapist of Ontario (CRPO).
- Clinical experience in providing assessment, individual and family therapy to children, adolescents and their families.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Experience with using a variety of evidence-based/informed treatment approaches such as CBT, DBT and/or McMaster Approach to Family Therapy.
- Experience in working in home and/or in the client's community preferred.
